

The Role of the Federal Agency Subcommittee of the North American Bird Conservation Initiative-US

First Meeting, December 15, 1999

1. To represent Federal agency interests in bird conservation relative to achieving the vision and goals of the North American Bird Conservation Initiative.
2. To provide a forum for the coordination of Federal activities (i.e., programs, budget, policies, research, etc.) for bird conservation within the United States, and for conducting strategic interagency planning.
3. To provide a forum for Federal agencies to share information, identify opportunities, and discuss issues in bird conservation.
4. To provide a forum for development and dissemination of public information relative to bird conservation.
